Sažetak

U ovom se članku analizira dosadašnja istraženost veza benediktinca Gottschalka s hrvatskom kneževinom u doba kneza Trpimira i njegov možebitni utjecaj na formiranje filozofskih ideja u Hrvatskoj tog doba. Iznešene su i primjedbe na olako interpretiranje u našoj filozofskoj literaturi Gottschalkove filozofske pozicije bez dubljih istraživanja. Na kraju autor iznosi svoje stavove o proučavanju srednjovjekovne filozofije i sukladno tome o daljem istraživanju o sudjelovanju Hrvata u filozofsko-teološkim raspravama srednjega vijeka u Zapadnoj Europi.

Gottschalk the Benedictine and Croatian Philosophical Archaeology

Abstract

This article analyses the research conducted thus far on the connections between Gottschalk the Benedictine and the Croatian principality during the rule of Trpimir the sovereign, and the latter's possible influence on the formation of philosophical ideas in Croatia at the time. The article also expresses objections with regard to our philosophical literature's lightly interpretation of Gottschalk's philosophical position that lacks deeper research. In the end, the author outlines his standpoints regarding the research in the philosophy of the Middle Ages and, accordingly, regarding future research on the participation of Croatians in the theological-philosophical discussions of the Middle Ages in Western Europe.
