It has been fifty years since the Institute of Philosophy in Zagreb, under the leadership of Vladimir Filipović, then director of the Institute, launched the journal *Contributions to the Research of Croatian Philosophical Heritage*. The journal was founded with the aim of publishing “original presentations of the unexplored thoughts of our philosophical ancestors.” In this spirit, part of our conference will be dedicated to the history of Croatian philosophy. However, we also seek to address contemporary trends in Croatian philosophy and the broader philosophical landscape in Croatia.

In addition to specific topics from the history of Croatian philosophy, we welcome discussions on:

- The problem(s) of national philosophies,
- The current state of research in Croatian philosophy,
- Possible directions for future research in Croatian philosophy, and
- Croatian philosophy in the broader European and global context.

We invite you to submit the title of your presentation and an abstract (up to 150 words) to hrvatska-filozofija2025@ifzg.hr by **2 June 2025**.

Notifications of acceptance will be sent by **1 July 2025**.

Each presenter will have **30 minutes** for their presentation and discussion.

The official languages of the conference are **Croatian and English**.

Accepted presentations that pass the review process will be published in *Contributions to the Research of Croatian Philosophical Heritage*.

The **registration fee is 30 euros per presenter**. Exemptions apply to unemployed individuals, retirees, employees of the Institute of Philosophy, and members of the Editorial Board of *Contributions*.
